



Homeshare Program

Affordable housing is a critical issue in our community, for seniors and for younger generations. The Senior Center is working with Vashon Household in developing a home sharing program to help address the lack of affordable housing available to workers and seniors on the island.

Home sharing is a simple concept that matches home providers (people with available space in their homes) with people who need housing. This not only helps to offer additional income for a home provider and affordable rent to home seekers but can also be helpful in providing assistance with household chores, landscaping and gardening tasks, social and connective support to people living alone.

Independent Caregiver Referrals

The Vashon Senior Center (VSC), and The Vashon Care Network (VCN) get frequent inquiries from islanders requesting referrals for independent caregivers.

As you know, many Vashon individuals and families face daunting challenges as they try to find a caregiver so they can remain safely in their own homes. The process involves overstressed family members and a shortage of caregivers. Need Help Understanding Medicare?

SHIBA offers workshops and information for current and new beneficiaries, those who will soon be eligible and anyone who wants to learn more about Medicare health coverage. Various plan options, prescription drug coverage, supplements, and ways to get help paying for Medicare will be discussed. This class is taught by a trained SHIBA advisor (Statewide Health Insurance Benefits Advisors).


